Dedication of the Wassmann Bench By Jerry Hayes, Historian, Benicia Historical Society

The dedication of a Memorial Bench honoring longtime Benicia residents Harry and Diane Wassmann will take place on Saturday, December 10, 2022 at 11:00 am. The bench has been installed at the west end of the Benicia Public Library (near the Sesquecentennial Clock) to honor their contributions and as a remembrance of these remarkable Benicia residents.

Harry Wassmann was born in Benicia and dedicated his entire life to recording and preserving Benicia's rich history. He was a founding member of both the Benicia Historical society and the Benicia (Camel Barn) Museum and contributed countless hours to the success of both organizations.

Harry's wife, Diane Wassmann, was a dedicated elementary school teacher at St. Dominic's School and retired from teaching after many years with the Benicia Unified school district at Robert Semple Elementary School. She was a member of the Friends of the Benicia Public Library since the inception of that organization and shared her love of reading at children's storytime when the library was still on East 'G' street.

Friends and family will gather for this dedication. The public is invited to join in honoring this talented and amazing couple.

The Solano Train Ferryboat Era – The Glory Days of the Historic Town of Benicia By Leann Taagepera

The Southern Pacific Railroad's train ferry Solano was a technological marvel and the largest train ferry in the world when it began service in 1879. Its home port was the town of Benicia, California's former Capital. After fifty-one years of ferrying trains, its service ended in 1930. It was replaced by a train bridge that spanned the Carquinez Strait and is still used today. The ending of the train ferry was a loss to the small, close-knit town of Benicia, as the Solano was important to the economics and every-day life of the townspeople. In fact, the ferry was beloved. Yet, Benicia was resilient and survived the loss of the ferryboat. The townspeople now appreciate its gloried past and revel in its scenic waterside location and the important parts it has played in our state's history, including that of the railroad.
